

AMNESTY PROGRAM

35th District Court Amnesty Program Information Sheet

AMNESTY FEE REDUCTIONS: During the period of amnesty, the civil infraction ticket will be reduced to the original fine and/or cost **plus** the \$45 driver's license clearance fee, if applicable. Upon full payment, the Court will notify the Secretary of State to lift the suspension. *The misdemeanor tickets will be reduced to the original fines and/or costs plus any mandated state costs.* Please contact the Court at (734) 459-4740 to verify the amount due.

To take advantage of this opportunity, please note the following:

1. **Timeframe:** The program will run **Thursday, July 8, 2021 through Wednesday, July 28, 2021.**
2. **Case Types:** Included are all payable traffic civil infraction and misdemeanor tickets issued within the jurisdictions of Cities of Northville and Plymouth, Townships of Northville, Plymouth and Canton.
3. **In Person:** Amnesty applies to those individuals who present themselves at the 35th District Court, 660 Plymouth Rd., Plymouth, MI 48170. The Court is open for business Monday through Friday from 8:30a.m. to 4:00 p.m. Covid protocols must be followed including Covid screenings, wearing masks and adhering to social distancing.

Online: Amnesty applies also to individuals who submit an online credit card payment through <https://payments.g2gcloud.com/DC35/1303> and includes the word "Amnesty" after the ticket or case #.

No mail in payments or phone payments will be accepted for this program.

4. **Payment Types:** ALL PAYMENTS MUST BE CASH, CERTIFIED CHECK, MONEY ORDER, PERSONAL CHECKS (with proper identification) OR CREDIT CARD. **No payment plans are allowed under the Amnesty Program.** All original fines and/or costs plus any mandated state costs must be paid with one payment by July 28, 2021.
5. **Warrants:** Under the program, individuals with arrest warrants for failure to appear in Court on a civil infraction or misdemeanor will have their outstanding warrant cancelled. These individuals may come to Court without the fear of being arrested for their voluntary appearance.
6. This is a one-time opportunity to clear a backlog of cases. After the program, the Court will continue to move more aggressively to enforce the collection on unpaid tickets, including all penalties and late fees.
